HEC Objection Handling and Rebuttals

<u>Use Case:</u> The objections and rebuttals below are the most common objections that HEC sales teams encounter – you probably will as well. The responses below will help you overcome the objection and continue the conversation about email security.

We're not looking for a new provider/vendor at this time.
